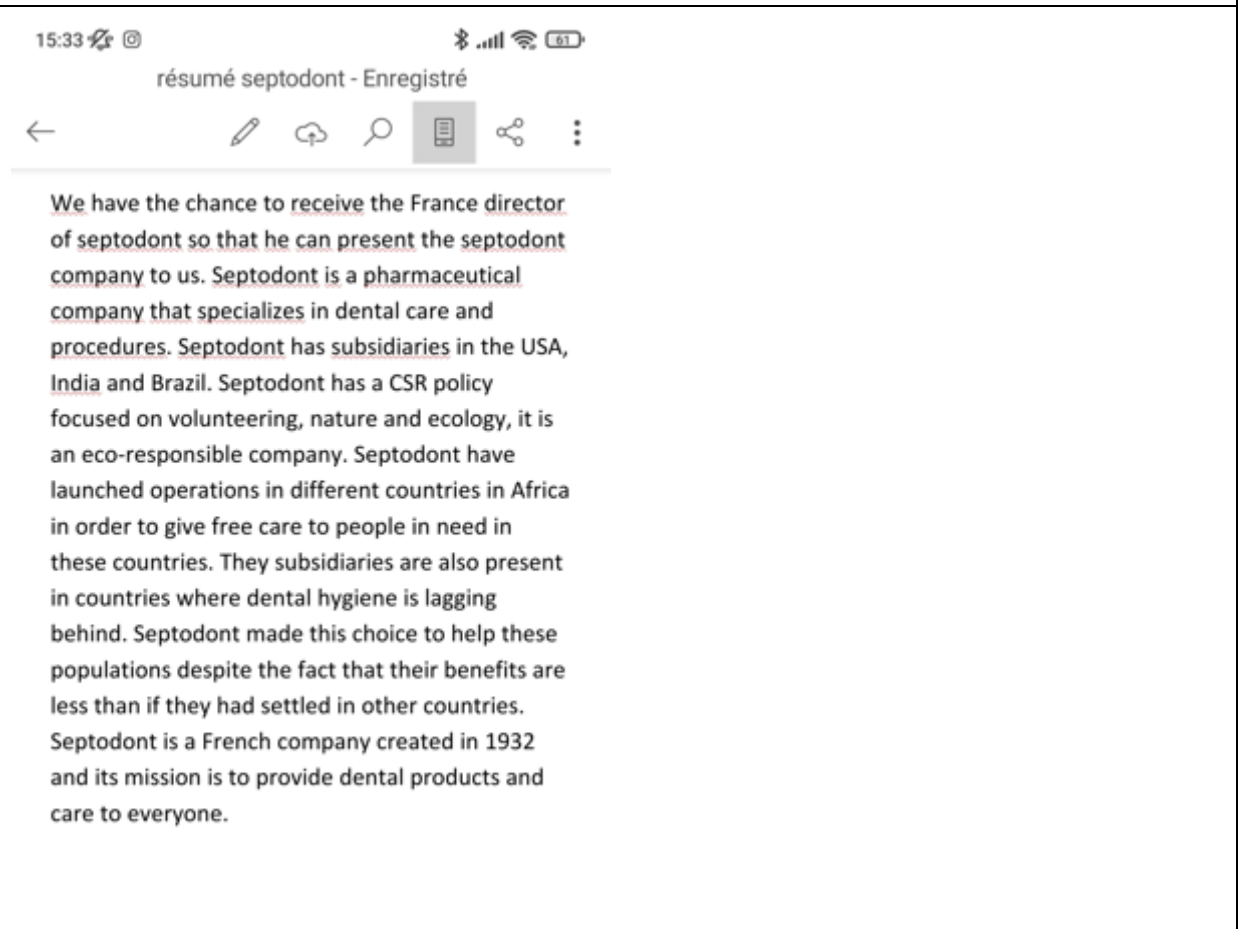
Also, during the day, we visited two companies: the first one, Fiera di Rimini and the second one, the SGR company. Obviously, we mainly told about CSR with these two companies.

04/10 :

Today, Tuesday 4th October, we visited the Marco Polo High school in Rimini. This school is specialized in tourism. The students introduced us and showed us the school. I was able to discover that it was a former fascist summer camp for children and then, during the war, that it had become a hospital. This building is M-shaped for Mussolini. Mussolini also said it was the most beautiful summer camp in Italy. During these camps, the children did gymnastics and, went to the beach.

Afterwards, we played sports in the school gymnasium with the Italians and the Croatians. It was a good way to socialize.

In the afternoon we visited the city of Rimini. We saw the arch leading to Rome which dates back 2000 years. we also saw the place of the three martyrs in homage to martyrs who died for the republic. Today, October 5, we started the day with a group activity at school . Afterwards, we met two people working for the "Distretto della Felicità" project. Then, we took the bus to go to Ravenna. Ravenna is an important city in Italy for art and monuments, it is best known for mosaics. This city has 8 monuments are recognized by UNESCO. Dylan **Septodont**

During the French trip, the French firm Septodont visited our school in the morning to introduce themselves. The vice president of the company, Mister Darribere, and the human resources responsible came to explain their role in the company and told us what the company is about, their goal, their history. Septodont is a pharmaceutical enterprise specialized in developing, manufacturing and distributing dental pain killers and dental consumables created in 1932 by the Schiller family. For example, they developed pain killers for all types of dental surgeries to reduce the pain during the surgery. They supply all pharmacies and hospitals with toothpastes, tooth prostheses. They have an international influence with several plants in India, USA and Brazil. They have partnerships with 150 countries and they are recognised to be one of the best pharmaceutical companies in their area for many years. They also have their head office near our school in Saint Maurice. The director explained their vision about the future of the company and their views about CSR. They are really concerned about global warming and do a lot of actions to try to prevent it. They reduced their carbon footprint by changing their means of transport or using recycled materials. They are a part of the ONF, a French association, which has the goal of planting over 15,000 trees per year in a reserved area. For the CSR they do voluntary work and donate to support dental health all over the world, especially in poor countries. Unfortunately we did not have the chance to visit the factory. It was really interesting to meet an international company. I was impressed by their determination about the future of the earth and global warming.

The 4th of October

We finally visited the Italian school and our Italian colleagues. The morning, they did a presentation of their school, its history. The building was built in 1930 by Mussolini, in order to be a summer camp for children. Here the children had a strict routine everyday to make them future good soldiers. There were almost 3000 children per year. During the Second World War, it was transformed to a military hospital where wounded soldiers can be healed. Soldiers had the chance to assist in a show made for them. After the war, the building again became a summer camp but some nuns were hosted there too. In 1980, it became a school. After the presentation, we did some sports activities and lunch. After lunch we visited Rimini. Here we discovered the Arch of August, and it was made by the Romans during the reign of the emperor August. This Arch is the gate to the road that links Rimini and Rome. Near the gate, is the place "Piazza Tre martiri". This place is named like that after three people died, killed by Nazies soldiers, at the end of the war because they wanted freedom. In this place, there is a statue of Julius Caesar and the church of Antonio de Padua. In one of the streets, there is an original Roman road. After we visited the temple of Malatesta where we can find the painting " Cross of Giotto ", Giotto is a famous painter in Italy. Near the temple is the place Cavour where there is a statue of the pope Paul V, the Pina fountain, the former fishmarket created in 1747 and the contemporary museum. Finally, the Italians told us about the Tiberio Bridge, created by the emperor Tiber. There is a legend about the bridge. It says that the Evil said that the bridge is unbreakable, and one day the Evil were very angry at the population because of a dog. So he decided to destroy the bridge with his foot, but the bridge

did not collapse because its unbreakable. The only thing that is left on the bridge is the Devil's footprint.

The 5th October

We attended a presentation about CRS. To prepare for it, we formed groups with Italian, Croatian and French students to exchange ideas about the CRS. First we answered the question "what's a good workplace" and we concluded that a good work environment is stressless, peaceful, respectful and gender equal. The second was "what's the main factors that make us choose a firm". For us, it's a company with a good location, paid lives, good schedule, well paid and good values like eco responsible. And so to be eco responsible, an enterprise can switch to smart work, at home, a bonus salary if we recycle and maybe the firm can pay the half of electric bike costs.

Finally the representatives came, the founder's daughter and his colleague. They are part of a non-profit association that helps especially the young women. It helps the young mothers to balance between the work life and the personal life in the shoe companies. The shoe companies are part of the footwear district, borned in 1900 to produce soldiers' shoes, and include over 2000 employees. This territory is unique for his small traditional companies that pass on their knowledge, generation on generation. In this moment the mix between work and personal life was easy to deal with because of the family structure. There is always someone at home to look after the children, but in our society we have a simple structure with two parents and the children. So the association called " Distretto della felicità" wants to change the system to help young mothers. Their idea is to change the work schedule by reducing the lunch break and finish the work earlier with the help of the unions, the firms, and the local administrations. Unfortunately they had to face difficulties and the first is the old males employees who do not agree with the schedule changes because of their habits. With experimentation, the questionnaire shows that the employees do agree with the changes. To go further they have the idea of reducing the work week. I think the présentation was interesting but I think the best was to see all the processing and the difficulties that they have to face. They have good values and they want to protect the ones that don't have a strong voice. That impresses me.

After we visited Ravenna, one the most important cities of Italy about art, Antique and Middle Age history. Here there are 8 monuments listed in UNESCO and we visited 5 of them. The first is the Saint - Apollinaire basilic, built during the V century under the reign of Theodore. There are beautiful mosaics that show the life of Jesus, 31 martyrs and 31 virgins. The 62 characters were added later. The body of Saint Appolinaire was transferred here. The second monument was the mausoleum of Theodore's daughter Galla Placita, where there are the burials of Galla's husband, her brother and her body even if we supposed that she would die in Rome. The third place was the Saint Vitale basilica built in 457 where the Saint was buried. The structure is an octagon with 2 floors : the first was reserved for the man and the second for women. The mosaics show the stories of the old and new testaments and the figure of Maximians. The fourth one is the orthodox baptistery or Neonian which is a sacred bath built by Bishop Ursus and decorated by Bishop Neon in 452. It shows the baptism of the christ. Finally the fifth place is the museum that collects the remains of the old ruined church or temple. I was really impressed by the beauty of the monuments and especially at what time they were made. They are still here after over 1500 years and bring a piece of the past.

The 6th October

Before leaving the school to go to Fiera di Rimini, we reformed the same group as yesterday to play a little quiz about CSR. It was about general facts but thanks to the quiz we learned that Howar Bowen is seen as the father of CSR. He is an American economist who wrote in 1953 the book, Social Responsibilities of the Businessman, which formed the first idea of companies' social responsibility. We also discovered the CSR pyramid developed by Archie Carrol in 1991. This system is a revolution because it's simple and timeless. The pyramid is divided in 4 parts : at the top, Philanthropic responsibilities, be a good corporate citizen ; the second, Ethical responsibilities, do what is just and ethic ; the third, Legal responsibilities, obey laws and regulations and the last part of the pyramid Economic responsibilities, be profitable.

Then we went to the Fiera di Rimini. The Fiera is a building built in 2001 and is a part of the Italian Exhibition Group. The build's surface is over 460, 000 Square meters, composed with 16 pavillons of 6000m², and here 70 000 employees worked in separated departements. Is mostly made with wood and glass to save light energy and the indoor heat. This company hostes expositions or exhibitions for other companies during festivals like the Ecomondo or the Key Energy expo. They are really concerned about ecology. They have zero impact on CO₂ thanks to the photovoltaic panels that cover over 100 000m², their air conditioner system. They organized different types of events like Rimini Wellness or music events. This tour is really interesting because this domain is not well informed by the common people.

After Fiera di Rimini, we went back to the center to meet the CSR's responsible, Elisa Tamagnini, for the company SGR. SGR is a gas and electricity seller founded in 1956 in Italy with over 27 subsidiary companies in Italy and Bulgaria. They are part of Call of Future, that is a website where companies can add what they do for the CSR. The firm is really concerned about the CSR because they have many projects about local administration or the earth. For example, they made a market where people can buy good and local products , even some people far from the market come. They invest in the research of skin cancer and in the screening of the populations of Rimini to prevent skin cancer. With the collaboration of AROP they buy a house where sick children's relatives in hospital can live to not rent a hostel. They donate food to homeless people and stuff to single mothers. Their new projects are school bullying prevention and ,with the help of the police, elders scamming. I think it is really impressive the number of actions they do for the community. They are a real part of the community and try to help it.

Finally in the evening, we met a counselor of the Rimini mayor. She asks us about what we can do for the youth to introduce them to politics, eco responsibility and culture. We answer to build a youth center, make the museum free, introduce new ecology jobs. It was pretty interesting to talk with a politician's representative and help her about how to improve the Rimini' politics.

The company promotes good working conditions (sport: Pilate/yoga/race) which I found very interesting and whose company shows philanthropy by helping people in difficult financial situations. (Holmes, orphans)

Tonight we will go swimming in the sea and the ERASMUS project invites us to dinner. This day was very enriching on the intellectual aspect

Today we attended a presentation by one of the partners, of the ERASMUS project. This partner was a company that helped other companies solve their problems. I found this very interesting despite the fact that the words used in English were very technical. We then took the bus to go to Ravenna. We had 1 hour to eat, so we ate in a restaurant of good quality, and Italian specialties. In a first time we walked to the basilica (1) a building with a garden that dates from the year 1400. Known for its gigantic tapestries. Then we went to visit a church, whose top of the bell exceeded 10/12 meters. It was built on a lake and little by little in the centuries it sank slightly into the lake. This building was impressive and was completely covered with marble despite the fact that the stained glass windows were not drawn this church was very beautiful. Following this we were able to walk freely in the city, we stopped in a bar to taste a « tiramisu » which was good. We were able to enjoy the sea in the late evening. It was a very good day in which I learned about the religious history of Ravenna.
